**NEVILLE PETER IN CONCERT.** Singer, pianist, composer, and recording artist Neville Peter will give a concert in the PUC Church Sanctuary today at 4:30 pm. Admission is free; a free-will offering will be collected. Born and raised on the beautiful island of St. Thomas, Neville Peter began to sing in church at about age five or six and began to study piano when he was 14. He was diagnosed with glaucoma at an early age and was completely blind by the age of 12. He was raised in an SDA home but strayed away from God in his youth. After a very successful career in secular music, Neville gave his life and talents completely to God in 1998 and has since penned more than 100 gospel songs. He has performed at the White House and Carnegie Hall and has appeared on many television programs.
