THE POSTLUDE TODAY honors the American Guild of Organists (which convened this week) with Myron Roberts' "Homage to Pérotin," a composer from the turn of the 13th century who directed the music at Notre Dame cathedral in Paris and who is often called the "grandfather of western church musicians." American composer Myron Roberts meant this musical homage to be a tribute to a composer often dismissed as primitive by uninitiated modern ears. Pérotin's music, however, was quite sophisticated and progressive in his own time and important to the development of polyphony.

Donna Mae Otis Thomas passed away peacefully at Rosehaven on Friday, June 21, at 92 years of age. Her husband, retired PUC history professor Dr. N. Gordon Thomas, preceded her in death December 13, 2021. They were married for 67 years. Donna was born February 21, 1932. Donna and Gordon were members of the PUC Church from December of 1968 until they transferred their membership to the St. Helena Church in 2008. Donna worked in various roles such as a secretary and social coordinator for President Rittenhouse at PUC and a secretary/receptionist for Dr. Williams at Angwin Dental. She sold antiques and did bed and breakfast. She served in women's ministries at the PUC Church and regularly volunteered at the Angwin Dorcas. Over the years she helped her husband plan and lead many college tours all over the world. Donna is survived by their three children Brent, Kimberly, and Brooke; grandchildren Tiara, Nathan, Matthew, Adam, and Brandon; and two great-grandchildren, River and Atlas.
