TODAY WE WELCOME Damian Chandler, pastor of the Capitol City SDA Church in Sacramento, as our guest speaker. Pastor Chandler was born in Canada and raised on the island of Barbados by his parents Michael and Grace Chandler. He began training for ministry in 1996 at Oakwood College in Huntsville, Alabama where he graduated with a Bachelor of Arts in Theology. He later attained a Master of Divinity degree from Andrews University. In 2001, he was appointed youth pastor of the Emerald City SDA Church in Seattle, Washington where he founded Impact Youth Ministries, an urban youth ministry focused on developing teens with a contagious and fearless faith. In 2008, he took leadership at both the Maranatha and Love of Life churches in Seattle. In 2011, he accepted a call to return to Alabama, where he served as associate pastor of the Madison Mission SDA Church. In 2015, he was installed as lead pastor of the Capitol City Church. He was the featured speaker at the 2019 International Pathfinder Camporee in Oshkosh. God has also used Pastor Chandler as choir director, composer, worship leader, and author. Pastor Chandler is married to Tanzy Chandler. They have three children, Zoe, Salem, and Levi.
